JOB DESCRIPTION - NURSE

- 1. Participate in Interdisciplinary Team meetings for the purpose of beginning, monitoring and following up on the individualized Habilitation Program.
- 2. Attend Inservice and Staff meetings conducted by the facility.
- 3. Cooperate in the Habilitation Team process to maximize client's functioning.
- 4. Licensed Practical Nurses and Registered Nurses shall work under the direction of the Director of Nurses and the Director.
- 5. Under the direction of the Program Director, supervise the Habilitation Aides in habilitation programming on each shift, evaluate performance of Habilitation Aides.
- 6. Prepare a nursing monthly summary indicating needs and services delivered in that month
- 7. Control communicable diseases and infection by recognizing such and:
 - A. Reporting such to the Director of Nurses, Director, Medical Director and Department of Health, if indicated.
 - B. Implementing appropriate protective and preventative measures according to facility & OSHA safety standards.
- 8. Perform general nursing duties, i.e. general medication administration, checking of vital signs, observing client behavior, condition and response to medication, treatments and therapeutic activities.
- 9. Assist direct care workers in hands-on care of the client when feasible.
- 10. Assist physicians with client care.
- 11. Receive and process orders from physicians.
- 12. Prepare necessary reports, i.e. controlled medication records, unusual incident reports, etc.
- 13. Comply with established policies and procedures and accepted standards of nursing practices to improve quality client care.
- 14. Treat client information as confidential and enforce client rights to maintain client dignity and self worth.
- 15. Maintain records to assure facility compliance with Patient Assessment-Resident Record Review Standards and other applicable laws and regulations.

- 16. Perform other duties as assigned by Director of Nurses, or Director.
- 17. Understand that all activity occurring on assigned shift is responsibility of nurse. The nurse is ultimately responsible and accountable.
- 18. Promote professionalism in all actions while promoting open communication with other staff members, residents, and families.

Qualifications:

All nurses (licensed Practical or Registered) employed by Blossom Hill shall have:

- 1. Current LPN or RN license or interim permit from State of Ohio
- 2. Be a graduate of an approved School of Nursing.
