Dear Blossom Hill families and guardians,

We hope this letter finds you well! In light of the Governor's recent announcement, we are amending our indoor visitation policy. We are allowing indoor visitation for guardians and close family members with the following guidelines in place:

- You must schedule your visit 48 hours in advance.
- You must schedule your visit with a House Manager or a Nurse
- Upon arrival, you must follow company protocol of having your temperature taken, answer health screening questions, and be assessed by the nurse on duty
- Complete Blossom Hill's Risk Assessment upon arrival or before you arrive
- Visitation should be one hour (max)
- When possible, conduct your visit in designated outdoor area
- Stay in designated area in each house for your visit
- Only two visitors will be allowed in the building at a time

Please note, these guidelines are subject to change as we are getting more information from our governing bodies on a daily basis. Blossom Hill will also use the risk assessment to determine if the visit will be safe on a case-by-case basis.

We are hopeful that indoor visitation will help you reconnect with your loved one.
